Introduction to Bilingual Geography

(geographical terms, weather, water cycle, climate graphs, directions, working with maps, the globe, positions in the graticule longitude and latitude, our rotating earth – day and night)

The Tropical Rainforest

(a day in the tropical rainforest, diurnal climate vs. out climate, layers of the tropical rainforest, nutrient cycle, comparing tropical rainforest and deciduous forest, the Yanomami, shifting cultivation/slash-and-burn-clearance, plantations and fair trade, destruction of tropical rainforest and consequences)

The cold zone

(race to the South Pole (Scott and Amundsen), polar day and polar night, comparison of Antarctica and the Arctic, the Inuit way of life (tradition and today), Greenland and North Atlantic ocean currents, Siberia, pipelines for the world, permafrost)

Hot deserts

(location of the earth's deserts, different kinds of deserts, how deserts are formed, how can people live in the deserts, oases)

The Earth and natural disasters

(time and longitude (rev.), solar radiation and insolation, climate zones and their location, earth's dynamic atmosphere, the structure of the Earth, plate tectonics, volcanoes, tsunamis)

USA

(topography, climate, historical development, farming in the USA/ agribusiness, industrial changes, suburbanization/gentrification)

Japan

(topography, Japanese culture, phases of industrial development, making room for growth, trade balance, economic sectors, health problems and environmental problems)
